### **General News**

Our medical and everyday transport bookings are increasing, and this means some days we reach capacity. Can I encourage you to book well in advance. Bookings that come in the day before (after 11am) do go on standby and we may not always be able to assist. We are also finding that we are getting bookings for places that are over 15kms and they do put a stretch on our resources. We often use taxies for these longer trips, and if you are unable to use a taxi, there may be times we won't be able to assist. Thank you for your understanding.

#### Guide To Bus Cost Bus Cost for The subsidised rate is for subsidised eligible clients over 65. It is clients called the Commonwealth Home Support Program (CHSP). The majority of Stryder's clients already receive CHSP subsidised rates. We also have a different bucket of funding we can use for eligible clients under 65. Please call the office and discuss with the client service team to see if you are eligible. Full Bus For clients who are on a Home Fare for Care Package (HCP), we charge our full fare for the trip to your Home Care HCP provider. Other clients Package who choose not to go through Clients My Aged Care are required to pay full cost to Stryder. Full Fare clients are required to set up a payment account with us and will be invoiced monthly. NOTE: Cost of trip only includes the bus trip. Any morning tea, lunch and entry fees are extra and paid directly to the venue (unless
